## More About Today's Worship

Our **antiphonal gospel reading** today is a common Christian liturgical practice derived from the music of New Testament Christians. Antiphony was probably entirely vocal, primarily congregational, and often followed the ancient Hebrew practice that frequently used this form. Antiphonal singing or reading in worship is a way of "taking turns" reciting a set form of words. Later, European (Italian) music in St. Mark's under the direction of Antonio Gabrieli codified the use of antiphonal choral singing as there were multiple choir lofts and choirs on opposite sides of the altar.
