### God's Vision For The Rest Of Your Life

### WHAT TO REMEMBER ABOUT THE PAST:

#### 1. REMEMBER WHEN YOU FIRST \_\_\_\_\_

#### 2. REMEMBER \_\_\_\_\_

"Remember the miracles He has done, His wonders, and His decisions."  
1 Chron. 16:12 (NCV)

"Remember that the Lord is the only God and that He is faithful."  
Deut. 7:9 (TEV)

### WHAT TO REMEMBER IN THE PRESENT:

#### 3. REMEMBER TO BE \_\_\_\_\_

"Make allowance for each other's faults and forgive the person who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others." Col. 3:13 (NLT)

#### 4. REMEMBER TO BE \_\_\_\_\_

"Remember the words of the Lord Jesus: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'" Acts 20:35 (NLT)

"Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously." 2 Cor. 9:6 (NIV)

### WHAT TO REMEMBER FOR THE FUTURE:

#### 5. REMEMBER GOD \_\_\_\_\_
